



# Immunization Clinic

## FRESNO COUNTY



The Fresno County Immunization Clinic provides low-cost vaccinations for those who are eligible for the Vaccine For Children or 317 programs

### VFC Eligibility

18 years of age or under and one of the following:

- Medi-Cal
- Uninsured
- American Indian or Alaskan Native

### 317 Eligibility

19 years of age and older and one of the following:

- Uninsured
- Underinsured

### Private Insurance\*

*The Immunization Clinic does not have a mechanism in place to bill Private Insurance. If you or your child are covered under private insurance, you may have to pay out of pocket*

**TB Skin Tests:** Available for those 18 years of age and under

**Patients are seen by appointment | Limited walk-ins available**

### What to bring to your appointment:

- **Vaccine Record**
  - For vaccine records that need to be translated, please bring a physical copy before your appointment
- **Medi-Cal card** (if applicable)
- **Photo ID of patient** (or parent/legal guardian if patient is a minor)
  - Note, if receiving COVID-19 vaccine only, no photo ID is needed



### Who can provide consent for a minor patient:

- **Parent**
- **Guardian** with any of the following documents:
  - Court-ordered guardianship documents
  - Caregiver's Authorization Affidavit signed within the last year
  - Adoption documents
  - Probate or conservatorship documents
  - Notarized letter giving the adult permission to provide medical consent for the minor
- **Minor**
  - Emancipated minor with documents
  - Minor who is 12 years of age and older may consent to immunizations that prevent sexually transmitted disease

### Vaccines for Travel



Certain travel vaccines are available. It is recommended that travelers plan ahead to receive their vaccinations at least 4-6 weeks before traveling as some vaccines need more than 1 dose. Contact the Immunization Clinic to schedule a travel vaccination appointment, please see contact information below
