

NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS ON THE SIERRA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND MEASURE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the Sierra Unified School District of Fresno County, California, that in accordance with the provisions of the Education Code of the State of California, an election will be held on November 5, 2024 within the District, at which election the following measure shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District and voted upon:

“To upgrade/repair/modernize our local high school and alternative education facilities, including repairing heating/air conditioning and leaky roofs, removing asbestos/lead/mold, and making safety improvements, shall Sierra Unified School District’s measure authorizing \$24,150,000 in bonds, at legal interest rates, and levying approximately \$45 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation (raising \$1.70 million annually) while bonds are outstanding, be adopted, with a board appointed citizens’ oversight committee and annual independent audits to assure proper expenditure of funds?”

Arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the Fresno County Clerk/Elections office at 2221 Kern St., Fresno, CA 93721, no later than Friday, July 12, 2024, by 5:00 pm. Paper copies of arguments must be submitted with original signatures, as well as by email to clerk-elections@fresnocountyca.gov in MS Word format. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the legislative body, or any member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations. If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only the first five persons signing, determined by the order in which their signatures appear, shall be printed with the argument.

Only one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters. Preference and priority in selection will be given in the order named: (1) The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body; (2) The individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measure; (3) Bona fide associations of citizens; (4) Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure. Any argument submitted shall not be changed after Friday, July 12, 2024, by 5:00 pm.
