Electrical work, grading, fence removal and installation and other appurtenant work as indicated on the plans and specifications is also part of the work.

3. Submission of Bids/and Bid Bonds & Bid Express – Jackie Wongsing
  - a. Bid Openings are conducted over Zoom with bids submitted via Bid Express. Contractors are encouraged to set up their FREE Bid Express accounts in advance. Bids can be saved, withdrawn and updated up until the time of the bid opening so we encourage bidders to try out the software in advance and call (559) 353-4919 or email
