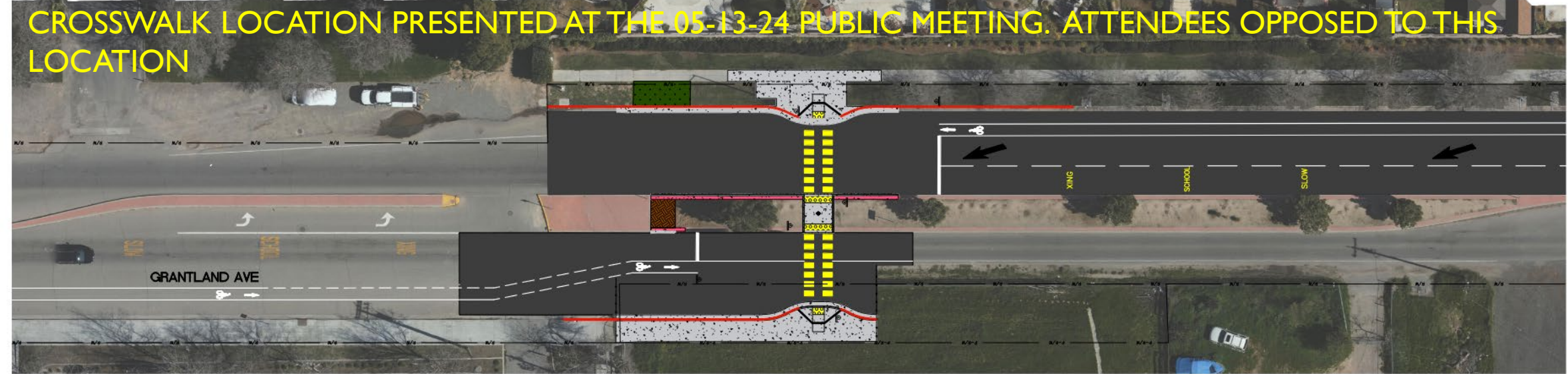
IMPROVEMENTS PROPOSED WITH PROJECT

- Relocate the existing crosswalk, install a High Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) system, and necessary signage and striping.
- The project will also include widening a section of the road to support building a new ADA compliant crosswalk, curb ramp and new sidewalk with curb & gutter, which would be aligned with and connecting to the existing sidewalk in front of the school.
- Right of way acquisition is necessary to accommodate the improvements on the west side of the crosswalk.

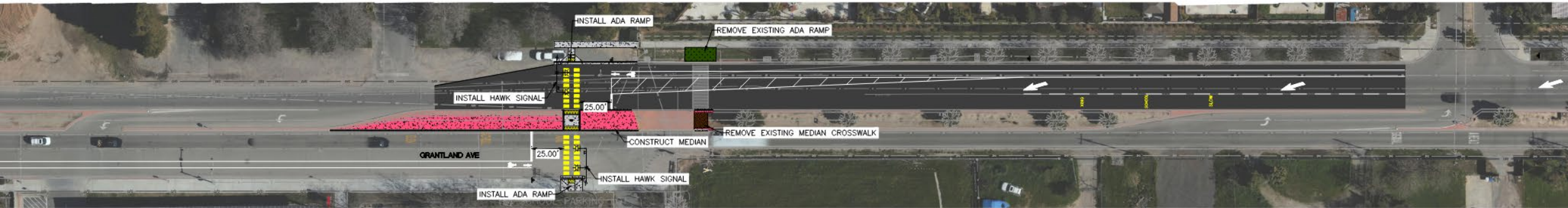

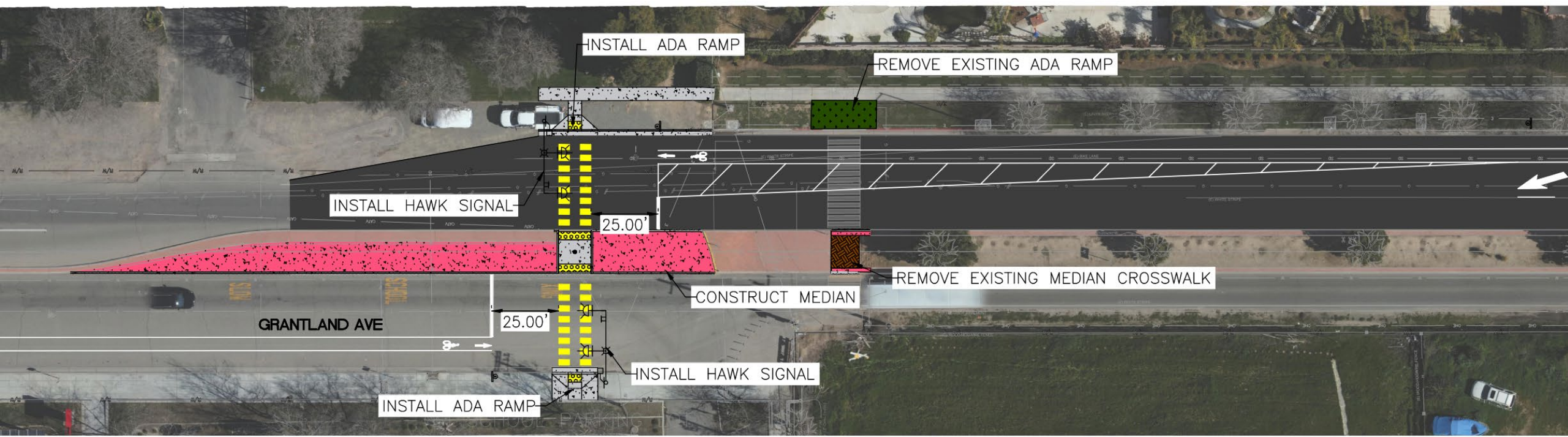

SCHEDULE

- December 2023 – County received authorization to start design
- Currently at 60% design
- September 2024 - Anticipated Right-of-Way Acquisition completion
- September 2024 - Anticipated design, construction and bidding documents completion
- January 2025 – Construction funding authorization
- February – April 2025 – Contract bidding and award
- August 2025 - Construction
